1. Candidate's scientific activities (0-15 points), including:

2. Candidate's additional activity (0-5 points)

participation in the Erasmus Plus programme	3
participation in student exchange programmes	1-3
awards, distinctions, scholarships	1-5
volunteer work	1-2

The final score shall be determined by the committee based on the evaluation of the specific achievement within the score presented in the table.

3. Scientific potential of the candidate (0-30 points)

Parts of the interview:

- presentation of the research project,
- presentation of scientific interests and past scientific achievements,
- discussion about scientific topics related to the thematic scope of the project elected by the candidate.

The following shall be taken into account when evaluating the interview:

- a) ability to formulate and present the research problem in the context of the current status of research in this area (0-10),
- b) proposed solution to the presented research problem (0-10 points),
- c) candidate's substantive knowledge in the light of discussed research or artistic topics (0-5 points),
- d) ability to conduct scientific discussions (0-5 points).

The final evaluation of the interview is the average number of points awarded by each member of the recruitment committee in each of the four categories.
