## **Subject and objectives of the conference**

The idea for the Interdisciplinary Balkan Studies Symposium arose following the conference “Political Order in the Balkans – Stabilising and Destabilising Factors,” held in June 2025. The organisers recognised that the issues raised at that time required deeper exploration and broader engagement to encompass new research horizons.

The goal of the Interdisciplinary Balkan Studies Symposium is to create a forum for the exchange of ideas for researchers representing various disciplines in the social sciences and humanities. Reflecting on the Balkan region as a space of dynamic historical, political, social, cultural, religious, and linguistic processes will help better understand its complex nature.

The organisers believe that the **dialogue between disciplines** and the confrontation of **diverse cognitive perspectives from different countries and academic traditions will become** a source of many inspiring debates and new research directions.

The conference will be devoted to broadly understood Balkan problems, analysed from both a local and global perspective – covering issues of big politics and the game of interests, as well as microhistory, new tendencies in reading ancient and contemporary literature, and changes taking place in the languages and cultures of the region.
